

Funeral costs can vary quite considerably but in order to help you have an idea of the prices for a typical traditional funeral we have listed below each of the elements and the associated cost.

Two tables of information are given owing to the difference between burial and cremation costs.

Other additional unavoidable third party costs (disbursements) are also detailed.

Disbursements are additional but unavoidable fees which must be paid in order for a funeral to take place and separate to the costs outlined in the director/arrangement fees.

These amounts are not within the control of Neville Funeral Service as they are set by third parties; the local council, the church and the British Medical Association.

Each disbursement fee will be itemised on the funeral estimate and the funeral account.

It is not possible to list the exact cost of disbursements as each crematoria, cemetery and church have different fees but we have detailed descriptions of each of the standard disbursement fees along with the associated rough estimate/average.

Additional items such as newspaper notices, extra limousines, flowers from our in-house florists and catering services can also be provided; prices are available on request.

Please be aware that prices shown in this price structure are correct at time of publication (November 2016) but are subject to alterations without notice at any time. The prices quoted may in certain circumstances vary from the published price list.
